



ADMISSION POLICY

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. For students of Seedling Public School

 - **b.** An interaction with the student and parent to understand the subject choices and aptitude.

2. For external applicants

- **a.** Successful completion of the grade 8 examination through CBSE, ICSE, MYP, CLSP or any other board.
- **b.** Successful clearing of entrance test in English & Mathematics for admission to the IGCSE Cambridge program.
- c. An interaction/interview to confirm the areas of interest, subject choices and aptitude to go ahead with IGCSE curriculum.







CONFIRMATION OF ADMISSION

Confirmation of admission will depend on

- The performance of the student in the Entrance Test and interview / interaction
- His/Her performance at the High School level.
- Co-curricular participation and achievements.
- Written recommendations from teachers/counselors.

OTHER INFORMATION

The school philosophy regarding discipline is based on trust and supervision, aiming at promoting self-discipline without diluting the standards. Students are expected to strictly follow the school rules and regulations in letter and spirit. In order to promote leadership qualities, students are appointed as Head Boy & Head Girl, House Captains, Prefects Discipline incharges and Cambridge representatives.

They are made responsible for the maintenance of discipline and the general conduct of the students under them. Major disciplinary decisions are made by a committee, which comprises of the Director, Principal and staff of the school.

The school is strictly secular and an attempt is made to provide the children with a strong moral code through a value based education system. The school is divided into four houses. The house system instils in the children a sense of loyalty and dedication. The children develop a keen competitive spirit through various Inter House competitions. Houses are named after the four signs Leo, Pisces, Sagittarius and Aquarius.







GUIDANCE FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS

- It is expected from all the parents to read and understand carefully the entire prospectus, especially courses of study and general School Rules.
- Parents are requested not to enter class-rooms either to see their wards or to seek interviews with the teachers during school hours. Interviews should be arranged through the Coordinator/Principal/Director only.
- They are requested to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and discipline and by taking interest in their children's work.
- They are required to inform the school if there is any change in their Address/Telephone Numbers.
- Leave for half day should be avoided, as far as possible, for security reasons. In emergency, written permission must be taken from the Coordinator/Principal/Director.
- Children, when sick, should not be sent to school to attend classes. The school must, however, be notified regarding the leave and the reason for the same.
- Parents' attention is drawn to the fact that criticism of a teacher or the school in the presence of a child causes the child to lose his or her respect for the teacher and will retard his or her progress.
- Any communication made by the parents should be addressed to the Coordinator/Principal/Director and not to the class-teacher, and all correspondence from the school to the parents must go through the Coordinator/Principal/Director.



POSITIVE REINFORCEMENTS

Student talent and abilities are nurtured through-

- Merit certificates given to all students excelling academically in specific subjects.
- Every achievement of a Seedlite is acknowledged and applauded in the school assembly by the students, teachers and management.
- Meritorious students are honoured with scholarships which are given away on the Annual Day by iconic quests.
- Appreciation certificates for full attendance, proficiency, good conduct are awarded annually to deserving students.
- Children participating in interhouse activities are given appreciation certificates, while the winners and runner-up receive trophies and prizes.
- On Sports Day all sportstars who have brought laurels to the school are appreciated with certificates, medals and cash vouchers.

Cambridge Examination body provides a range of modified materials in case of special requirement. The special needs should be identified well before and proper documentation should be done.






It may take several months for some special arrangements to be made, hence making applications as soon as possible is recommended.

TEMPORARY SPECIAL NEEDS

Temporary special needs may result from accidents / illness etc. Such needs should be reported to the Coordinator as soon as possible after the problem arise together with the case history and professional reports regarding the candidate.






Social Service Programmes: Various social service programmes are organized by the school to inculcate the value of dignity of labour and compassion for the less fortunate sections of the society. As a part of various programmes, students offer their services to institutions who take care of these people.

Other activities / Beyond the Classrooms: Various activities regularly held for the overall development of the child are Drawing and Painting Competitions, Recitation Contests, Debates, Extempores, Group Discussions, Cultural and Variety Programmes, Nature Care, Educational Visits to the Museum, Zoo, Gardens, Planetarium etc.

Spic - Macay: The school is a member of SPIC-MACAY and regularly conducts programmes of artists of International repute for the students with the aim of enhancing cultural sensitivity and understanding amongst students with special reference to Indian Music and Dance.

Band: The school also has its own band trained by a competent band master.

Educational and Adventure Tours: The school organizes activities like mountaineering and nature walk from time to time to provide first hand knowledge and training to students.

Health and Medical care: The school pays special attention to the students' well being. All students are put through an annual medical examination by specialists. Health cards are prepared and maintained for all students.

SAP: SAP refers to Student Activity Programme where students are free to choose games and service activities in which they are interested.



NOTE

- Each student of Cambridge curriculum is required to sign in the class to ensure presence is recorded.
- Parent cooperation is solicited to ensure attendance requirements are met.
- Minimum 90% attendance in compulsory for all Cambridge students in each subject.
- In case of unexplained absence, the coordinator must be informed.
- In case of a severe medical condition, a medical recommendation from a
 Doctor is required to be submitted to the Home room teacher or/and the
 coordinator so that additional provision may be made for the students to
 cope with pending learning. The contact time for this will not exceed
 preparation time of one contact class.







ATTENDANCE POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to encourage daily attendance in all classes. Attendance at school is essential if a student expects to do well. Regular attendance is necessary for successful completion of required class work and promotion to the next grade. Moreover, attendance and participation in class are integral parts of the teaching-learning process, and regular attendance develops patterns of behavior essential to successful personal, social and professional life.



PARTNERSHIP

It takes a whole community to raise a child who is healthy, caring and responsible. In school, this community starts with the network formed by parents, teachers and administrators who understand that their job is to work together to support and guide the development of each child. Seedling believes parents can be our most powerful and valuable allies in our pursuit for excellence in education. Since a positive parent-teacher partnership is vital to your child's success in school, Seedling organises parent-teacher meetings frequently, from time to time. Parents are encouraged to keep the lines of communication open with the school so that the child feels that the important people in his life are working together.



Transport

A fleet of cabs, buses & autos provides a regular service from the school premises to different places. Students availing of the school transport facility are properly cared for. The GPS enables parents to keep track of their kids and be assured of their safety.

Book Store

The school has a well stocked book store in the premises for day to day requirements of children.

Code of Conduct - School Rules

- Students should come to school at least 5 minutes before the bell rings for Assembly. Any student found to be reporting late to school frequently, will have to pay a fine.
- The school is not responsible for the loss of articles or money belonging to the student.
- Actions that disrupt the educational process are not acceptable behaviour.
- Every student is urged to contribute to the discipline and high standard of the school by his manners and conduct. Courtesy and consideration for all members of the school community are expected.
- Any kind of damage to the school property is to be made good by the parents.









- Students should use appropriate language in school and not meddle with the affairs of others.
- No student is allowed to carry cell phones to school and the same will be confiscated by the school if it is found in the student's possession.
- Pushing, swearing, shoving, hitting and kicking each other will be unacceptable, even if it is done in fun. Physical assault will be dealt with severely, by suspension.
- If a child is suffering from any serious medical condition, a letter to the Principal/Class teacher at the beginning of the year is essential.
- Parents must ensure proper -turnout of their wards. School uniform must be neat and properly ironed and worn on all days. No fancy hairstyles, streaked hair, eye make up or painted nails are permitted.
- Students must uphold the dignity of school programmes by actively organising, participating and helping.
- All possible arrangements are made to prevent students from leaving the school campus without permission. If, however, a student absconds i.e. leaves the campus without permission, the school will not be held responsible.
- The school is a no-smoking zone. Parents/Guardians are reQuested to refrain from smoking on the campus.
- To maintain discipline and to inculcate the habit of punctuality overstay of leave/absence is liable to a fine. The Quantum to be levied is determined by the school authorities from time to time.
- Students must endeavour to maintain cleanliness in the campus and also help in maintaining the school as an ecologically 'green' school.
- Students are not allowed to use the school telephone without permission. For any emergency, due permission may be sought from the Principal/Vice Principal to make as call.
- No collection of money, for any purpose whatsoever, will be made in the school without prior permission of the Principal/Director.

- Instead of lamenting or grumbling over the evils of this world, they should try to contribute their share in making it a better place to live in.
- They should take pride in wearing their school uniform. They should be brave and courageous and should express themselves freely, but with politeness.
- They should look upon people from all parts of the world as their brethren, irrespective of their colour and creed.
- The should accept their mistakes boldly, in case they commit any, on the other hand they should be strong enough to deny any charges against them, provided they have not done anything wrong.
- Bursting of crackers and playing with colours on the school premises during Diwali and Holi is liable to lead to expulsion of a student from the school.
- They should not drive a vehicle or a two wheeler without a proper driving licence and the helmet is a must for those students driving a two wheeler.
- They should attend and maintain the dignity and sanctity of the school assembly.



Academic Honesty

Both academic honesty and personal integrity are fundamental components of a student's education and holistic development. An academically honest student produces work representative of his/her own efforts and abilities. Contingent upon creating an atmosphere encouraging academic honesty students must be made aware that teachers will not ignore or condone any form or act of academic dishonesty including malpractice, plagiarism etc. Also that the teachers, administrators, parents / guardians will hold students accountable for any act of academic dishonesty.

Once the student realizes that an act of academic dishonesty affects the entire school community, he/she develops a sense of responsibility which makes him an asset to society.

The following activities are considered as misconduct and must be avoided.

- Falsification of records
- Misrepresentation of the school
- Coming late and leaving early without permission.
- Continuous failure in following the uniform code and in doing H.W.
- Wilful destruction, sabotage and theft of school property.
- Failure or refusal to follow school norms or teacher's instructions.
- Disorderly/indecent behaviour, use of inappropriate language.
- Carrying cell phones/gadgets which are not permitted to school.
- Bunking school/regular classes.
- Verbal/Physical assault, bullying of peers/juniors.
